



EDUCATION AMENDMENT ACT 1981

TABLE OF PROVISIONS

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 46AA of the *Education Act* 1932 (Exemptions).

AN ACT to amend the Education Act 1932 for the purpose of exempting certain teachers from the registration requirements of that Act.

[Royal Assent 21 October 1981]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Education Amendment Act* Short title. 1981.

2—Section 46AA of the *Education Act 1932** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by inserting “(1)” before “The Minister”;
- (b) by adding the following subsection as subsection (2) of that section:—

(2) The Minister, or an officer of the Department authorized by the Minister, may, by writing under his hand, exempt a person who—

- (a) is a graduate of a tertiary institution which is approved by the Registration Board; and
- (b) is employed to teach at Higher School Certificate level for a maximum of 6 hours a week and for a period not exceeding 2 years,

from all or any of the provisions of this Part.
