AN ACT to amend the *Electoral Act 1907* for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the forms of nomination for candidates for election to the Legislative Council and House of Assembly.

[Royal Assent 19 July 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Electoral Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day fixed by proclamation under section 2 (2) of the *Constitution Amendment Act 1983*.

3—Schedule 3 to the *Electoral Act 1907** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting “MEMBER” in the heading to Form 1 and substituting “CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO”;
- (b) by omitting “as a Member of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Tasmania for the said Division” in Form 1 and substituting “as a candidate for election as a Member of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Tasmania for that Division”;
- (c) by omitting clause 3 of the declarations that are required to be made and endorsed on the back of Form 1;
- (d) by omitting “MEMBER” in the heading to Form 1A and substituting “CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO”;
- (e) by omitting “as a Member of the House of Assembly of the Parliament of Tasmania for the said Division” in Form 1A and substituting “as a candidate for election as a Member of the House of Assembly of the Parliament of Tasmania for that Division”;
- (f) by omitting clause 3 of the declarations required to be made and endorsed on the back of Form 1A.
