

ELECTORAL AMENDMENT ACT 1983

AN ACT to amend the Electoral Act 1907 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the forms of nomination for candidates for election to the Legislative Council and House of Assembly.

[Royal Assent 19 July 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act 1983. Short title.

Commencement. 2—This Act shall commence on the day fixed by proclamation under section 2 (2) of the Constitution Amendment Act 1983.

Amendments to Schedule 3 to Electoral Act 1907,

- **3**—Schedule 3 to the *Electoral Act* 1907* is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by omitting "MEMBER" in the heading to Form 1 and substituting "CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO";
 - (b) by omitting "as a Member of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Tasmania for the said Division" in Form 1 and substituting "as a candidate for election as a Member of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Tasmania for that Division";
 - (c) by omitting clause 3 of the declarations that are required to be made and endorsed on the back of Form 1;
 - (d) by omitting "MEMBER" in the heading to Form 1A and substituting "CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO";
 - (e) by omitting "as a Member of the House of Assembly of the Parliament of Tasmania for the said Division" in Form 1A and substituting "as a candidate for election as a Member of the House of Assembly of the Parliament of Tasmania for that Division";
 - (f) by omitting clause 3 of the declarations required to be made and endorsed on the back of Form 1A.
