AN ACT to amend the Electoral Act 1985

[Royal Assent 25 October 1991]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short Title

1—This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment (Miscellaneous) Act 1991.

Commencement

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the *Electoral Act 1985* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 69 amended (Issue of writs for holding Assembly general election in specified circumstances)

4—Section 69 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting all the words after "Governor" and substituting "not less than 5 days and within 10 days after that publication or the expiry of those terms".
