AN ACT to amend the Evidence Act 1910

[Royal Assent 15 October 1991]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Evidence Amendment Act (No. 2) 1991.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Evidence Act 1910* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 134 amended (Depositions under the Justices Act 1959)

- 4—Section 134 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting everything after paragraph (a) and substituting the following:—
 - (b) if the witness is kept out of the way by the person accused—

and the court is satisfied that the deposition was given before justices or received as evidence by justices.
