**AN ACT to amend the Education (Teachers Federation) Act 1974 for the purposes of making further provision in respect of leave of absence of any teacher who holds an office with the Tasmanian Teachers Federation.**

**[Royal Assent 1 April 1981]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—This Act may be cited as the *Education (Teachers Federation) Amendment Act 1981*. Short title.

Principal Act. **2**—In this Act, the *Education (Teachers Federation) Act 1974\** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of long title to Principal Act. **3**—The long title to the Principal Act is amended by omitting “ full time president ” and substituting “ a full time officer ”.

Amendment of section 2 of Principal Act (Leave of absence of teacher during period of office with Federation). **4**—Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

(a) by being renumbered as subsection (1);

(b) by omitting from subsection (1) “ grant leave of absence without pay to a teacher for any period during which he holds the office of president of ” and substituting “ , subject to subsection (2), grant leave of absence without pay to a teacher for a period not exceeding 4 years during which he holds an office with ”;

(c) by adding the following subsection:—

(2) The Director-General shall not grant leave of absence to a teacher under subsection (1) if, on the granting of that leave, more than 3 teachers would be absent pursuant to that subsection at any one time.
