2. Grant of pension to Emma Grace Twitchett.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a Pension to Emma Grace Twitchett the Widow of George Twitchett, formerly a Sergeant in the Police Force of this State. [28 November, 1936.]

WHEREAS Sergeant George Twitchett, then a Detective Preamble. Constable, in the execution of his duty, rendered exceptional and meritorious service to the State during the year one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, in the course of which the said officer contracted serious permanent physical disabilities, as a result of which he has since died:

And whereas it is desirable that provision should now be made for the support of *Emma Grace Twitchett*, the widow of the said Sergeant George Twitchett.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as the Emma Grace Twitchett Pension Act 1936.

Grant of pension to Emma Grace

- 2—(1) There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue, which, to the necessary extent, is hereby appropriated accordingly, to Emma Grace Twitchett, the widow of George Twitchett, formerly a Sergeant in the Police Force of this State, an annual pension of fifty pounds during herwidowhood and until she attains the age of sixty years.
- (2) Such pension shall be payable monthly, commencing from the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
- (3) Upon the said *Emma Grace Twitchett* attaining the age of sixty years the pension pavable to her during her widowhood shall be reduced to thirty-two pounds ten shillings: Provided that if the Governor is satisfied that the said *Emma Grace Twitchett*, having attained the age of sixty years, is not eligible for or has not obtained any old age pension payable under the laws of the Commonwealth, the pension payable under this Act may be restored to the annual sum of fifty pounds.
