AN ACT to continue certain expiring Laws. [14 December, 1950.]

WHEREAS the Acts mentioned in the schedule to this Act PREAMBLE. are, in so far as they are in force and are temporary in ^{Cf. 12} & 13 their duration, limited to expire on the thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and fifty:

And whereas it is expedient to provide for the continuance, as in this Act mentioned, of those Acts and of the enactments amending or affecting the same:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

CURRIE WATER.

No. 75 of 1950.

AN ACT to authorise the Council of the Municipality of King Island to borrow an Amount not exceeding Twenty-five thousand Pounds, to make Provision for the Supply of Water to the Town of Currie in the Municipality of King Island and the Inhabitants thereof and to confer on the Council Powers needed for the Construction of necessary Works therefor.
