AN ACT to amend the Environment Protection Act 1973.

[Royal Assent 1 November 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Environment Protection Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day fixed by proclamation under section 2 (2) of the *Groundwater Act* 1985.

3—Section 25 of the *Environment Protection Act* 1973* is amended by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:—

(6) Where a proposed licence relates to the operation of a site to be used for the disposal of solid or liquid refuse or trade wastes, the Director shall, before granting the licence, consult with the Director of Mines as to the effect of granting the licence.
