AN ACT to abolish entertainments tax.

[14 October 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Entertainments Tax (Repeal) Short title. Act 1976.

Abolition of entertainments tax.

- **2**—(1) No entertainments tax is payable under the *Entertainments Tax Act* 1953 in respect of any entertainment held on or after 1st December 1976 and accordingly, on that date, the Acts specified in the Schedule are repealed.
- (2) Nothing in this section affects any liability arising in respect of any entertainment held before 1st December 1976 and accordingly the Acts repealed by this Act continue to have effect in relation to any such entertainment.
