

south-eastern angle thereof; again on the south by the southern boundary of the said 5a. Or. 7p. westerly to the south-western angle thereof and by a continuation of this westerly line, again crossing the said Derwent Valley Railway and crossing the Main Road to Westerway, the Crown Reservation and the said Russell Falls River to the western bank of that river; thence by the said western bank in north-westerly and north-easterly directions to the south eastern angle of lot 13990 25a. 1r. 34p. granted to Louis Manton Shooobridge again on the south by the southern boundary of that grant westerly to the south western angle thereof; thence on the west by the western boundary of the last mentioned grant northerly to the southern bank of the Russell Fall Creek; thence on the north-west by that bank of the said creek north easterly to its junction with the said Russell Falls River and crossing that river to the eastern bank thereof; thence by that bank of the said river in a general south-easterly direction (twice again crossing the said Derwent Valley Railway and again crossing the said Main Road) to the point of commencement.

AN ACT to amend the *Exton Water Act 1947*.  
 [15 May, 1952.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Exton Water Act 1952*. Short title and citation.  
 (2) The *Exton Water Act 1947*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section twenty-nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word “seven” and substituting therefor the word “ten”. Borrowing powers.
