"(2) The regulations may provide that the holder of a forest permit shall be responsible for ensuring the payment to all persons employed in the exercise of any of the powers and authorities granted by such permit of not less than the wages or remuneration determined by the relevant wage-fixing authority in respect of employment in the class of workers in which such persons respectively are engaged; and for the cancellation of such permit for the breach of any such regulation."
