AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act 1935. [7 December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Act 1950.
- (2) The Fisheries Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Certain provisions to apply only in respect of advances under Part III. 2 Section fifty-eight A of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "shall" the words "(except in respect of fish taken, bought, or sold, or offered or exposed for sale, in contravention of any provision of this Act)".
