how effected.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (4) and substituting therefor the following subsections:—

“(4) Before a dog is registered there shall be paid to the clerk the fee fixed by the council pursuant to subsection (5) of this section, or, if the registration is effected after the thirty-first day of December in any financial year, one-half of that fee.

“(5) For the purposes of subsection (4) of this section, the council may fix fees by resolution, with power to discriminate according to the sex and kind of dog, but no fee so fixed shall be more than one pound or less than five shillings.”.

### No. 35 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Firewood Act* 1951.

[23 October, 1953.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Firewood Act* 1953.

(2) The *Firewood Act* 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “pounds” in paragraph (f) of subsection (1) the words “ten shillings”.

**3** Section seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the numerals “1953” and substituting therefor the numerals “1954”.
