AN ACT to amend the *Fisheries Act 1935*. [26 June 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fisheries Act 1958*.

(2) The *Fisheries Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) the word “six” and substituting therefor the word “eight”;

(b) by omitting paragraph v of that subsection and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“v Four members shall be appointed to represent licensed fishermen, of whom one shall represent fishermen residing on the North-West Coast, one fishermen residing on the North and North-East Coast, one fishermen residing on the East Coast, and one fishermen residing on the South and South-West Coast of this State respectively.”; and

(c) by omitting from subsection (6) the word “Three” and substituting therefor the word “Four”.
