AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act* 1921. [19 December 1958.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Marine Act 1958.

Short title and citation.

(2) The Marine Act 1921, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section sixty-four of the Principal Act is amended by General omitting paragraph XVI and substituting therefor the follow-boards. ing paragraphs:—

> " XVI To let, or grant a licence to use or occupy, any wharf, work, building, or land for a term not exceeding three years, or, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding twenty years:

> " XVIA To let any land on a building lease, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding ninety-nine years:".

AN ACT to amend the *Firewood Act* 1951. [19 December 1958.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Firewood Act* 1958. Short title (2) The *Firewood Act* 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

"7 This Act shall expire on the thirty-first day of Decem-Expiry of ber 1959.".
