AN ACT to amend the *Firewood Act* 1951.

[19 December 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Firewood Act* 1960.

(2) The *Firewood Act* 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

FILLED MILK (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the *Filled Milk Act* 1960.

[19 December 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Filled Milk Act* (No. 2) 1960.

(2) The *Filled Milk Act* 1960 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Advisory

2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of subsection (2) the words “legally qualified medical practitioner” and substituting therefor the word “person”; and

(b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of that subsection the word “person” and substituting therefor the words “legally-qualified medical practitioner”.
