- (v) If this agreement is terminated, any credit balance shall be divided equally between the parties, but any debit balance shall be paid by the Trust; and
- (d) To meet the basic cost of operating the Theatre Royal (estimated at £3,000 per annum), the Trust will guarantee lettings from Trust and joint productions sufficient to occupy the Theatre for twenty weeks in every year at an average rental of £150 per week, but if it is unable to do so, the Trust will pay in cash any deficiency in rental to the Society.
- 8. THE Treasurer will pay off the total indebtedness of the Society to the Commonwealth Trading Bank of Australia secured by mortgage upon the Theatre Royal.
- THIS Agreement shall not be varied or terminated before the first day of October 1963 and shall continue thereafter unless terminated by the Trust or the Society by three months' written notice to the other.
- 10. THIS Agreement shall take effect when ratified by the Parliament of Tasmania.

## FIREWOOD.

## No. 37 of 1962.

## AN ACT to amend the Firewood Act 1951. [1 October 1962.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Firewood Act 1962.
- (2) The Firewood Act 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Expiry of Act.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the numerals "1962" and substituting therefor the numerals "1963".
