

FATAL ACCIDENTS.

No. 43 of 1956.

AN ACT to amend the *Fatal Accidents Act* 1934.
[29 November 1956.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fatal Accidents Act* 1956.

(2) The *Fatal Accidents Act* 1934, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Exclusion of payments by insurers in assessment of damages.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) the words “funeral expenses” and substituting therefor the words “expenses of the funeral or cremation”; and

(b) by inserting in that subsection, after the word “person”, the words “and the reasonable cost of erecting a headstone or tombstone over the grave of the deceased person”.

TUBERCULOSIS.

AN ACT to amend the *Tuberculosis Act* 1949.
[29 November 1956.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Tuberculosis Act* 1956.

(2) The *Tuberculosis Act* 1949, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Offences.

2 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the word “wilfully”.
