AN ACT to amend the Forestry Act 1920.

[Royal Assent 3 October 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the *Forestry Amendment Act 1986*. Short title.
- 2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commencement.

Principal Act. **3**—In this Act, the *Forestry Act* 1920* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 9A of Principal Act (Chief Commissioner for Forests and Assistant Commissioners).

4—Section 9A (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “special knowledge and experience in all branches of forestry” and substituting “proven administrative skills and a sound knowledge of, and experience in, forestry”.
