### AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act 1959

# [Royal Assent 10 November 1994]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

#### Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1994.

### Commencement

2—This Act commences on a day to be proclaimed.

## Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Fisheries Act 1959\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

## Section 36 amended (Regulations)

- 4—Section 36 (1) (b) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
  - (a) by inserting ", transfer and renewal" after "for the issue";
  - (b) by inserting ", transfer, renewal" after "regulating the issue";
  - (c) by omitting subparagraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) and substituting the following subparagraphs:—
    - (i) for the issue, transfer and renewal of licences to take fish commercially on any prescribed terms and conditions; and
    - (ii) for the renewal of a licence to which subparagraph (i) applies on payment of a prescribed fee; and
    - (iii) for the sale of licences to which subparagraph
      (i) applies by tender or any other process approved by the Commission; and
    - (iv) for the limitation to a prescribed number of the number of licences to take any prescribed kind of fish that may be issued;

# Section 42D amended (Regulations as to sale, &c., of fish)

5—Section 42D (2) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (a) the following paragraph:—
(ab) providing for the charging of fees for the registration of a person referred to in paragraph (a);
