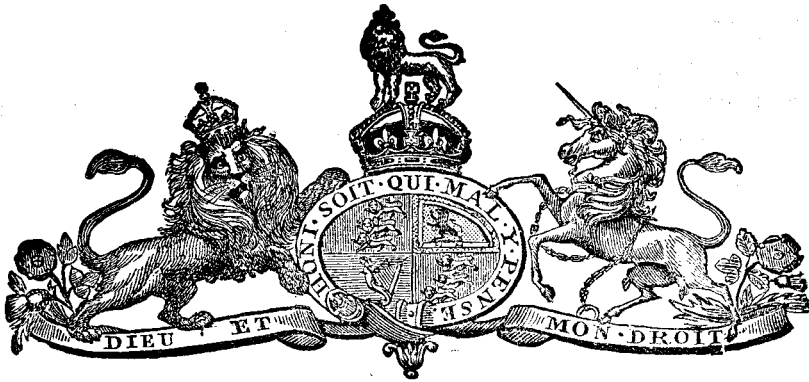

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Federal Aid Roads Execution Act (No. 2) 1934.* Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act shall be incorporated with the *Federal Aid Roads Execution Act 1932.* 23 Geo. V. No. 7.
