

ANALYSIS.

- 1. Short title and incorporation.
- 2. Power to Minister to cause works to be executed,

AN ACT to authorise the Execution of certain Federal Aid Road Works [20 December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Federal Aid Roads Execution Short title and Act (No. 2) 1935.

- (2) This Act shall be incorporated with the Federal Aid Roads 23 Geo. V. No. 7. Execution Act 1935.

Power to Minister to cause works to be executed. 2 The Minister may cause the Federal Aid Road works specified in the schedule to be executed and carried out at a cost for each separate work so specified not exceeding the amount set forth in the schedule in respect thereof.
