AN ACT to authorise the Execution of certain
Federal Aid Road Works and Federal Aid Works. A.D.
1943
[25 November, 1943.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Federal Aid Roads and Works Execution Act (No. 2) 1943*. Short title
and incor-
poration.

(2) The *Transport Act 1938* shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Federal Aid Roads and Works Act 1937* and this Act. 2 and 3 Geo.

A.D. 1943. **2** The Federal Aid Road works and Federal Aid works specified in the first and second schedules may be executed and carried out at a cost for each separate work so specified not exceeding the amount set forth in the schedules in respect thereof.
