AN ACT to amend the *Fire Brigades Act* 1920. A.D.
1944.
[14 July, 1944]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fire Brigades Act* Short title and
citation.

(2) The *Fire Brigades Act* 1920,* as subsequently amended,
is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection—

“(3A) In any case where a board borrows any moneys in accordance with subsection (3), the Governor may, on such terms and conditions as he considers necessary, guarantee the payment by the board of the principal moneys so borrowed or of any part thereof and of the whole or any part of the interest payable by the board in respect thereof.”.
