AN ACT to amend the Fruit Board Act 1934.

[1 October 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fruit Board Act 1975.

Short title and citation.

(2) The Fruit Board Act 1934 as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Determination of licence fees.

2 Section 14E of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words "one dollar" and substituting the numeral and word "5 dollars".

Legal proceedings.

3 Section 30 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word "Minister" and substituting the word "Board".

Regulations.

- 4 Section 31 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsections:—
- "(4) The regulations may prescribe the charges and fees to be levied in respect of the hire of containers and for cartage of fruit for processing.
- "(5) The regulations may prescribe penalties not exceeding \$750 for breaches of the regulations.
- "(6) For the purposes of the regulations the weight of fruit received by the processor shall be presumed to be the weight of fruit suitable for processing.
- "(7) For the purposes of the regulations the designation of the grade of apples at the time of receipt by the processor shall be presumed to be the grade of apples actually purchased and the onus of proving that such apples were wholly or in part of some lesser grade shall be on the person alleging such change of grade.".
