AN ACT to amend the *Farmers' Debt Adjustment Act 1936.* [1 November, 1938.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Farmers' Debt Adjustment Act 1938.* Short title.

2—(1) Except as hereinafter provided every application under section eighteen of the Principal Act shall be made on or before the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight. Limitation of time for applications.

(2) If at any time after the date aforesaid, the Governor is satisfied that—

- i. Owing to seasonal or market conditions, or to fluctuations in prices of primary products it is necessary that provision should be made for the adjustment of the debts of farmers : and
- ii. Sufficient funds standing to the credit of the suspense account mentioned in section forty-seven of the Principal Act, are available for the purpose—

the Governor may direct the Board to receive and deal with applications lodged under section eighteen of the Principal Act on or before a date to be specified in such direction.
