AN ACT to amend the Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945. [23 October, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and eitation. 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1953.

(2) The Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
