## FRUITGROWERS' DEFENCE FUND.

No. 26 of 1953.

### AN ACT to amend the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945.* [23 October, 1953.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1953.*

(2) The *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

Certain securities and moneys to vest in the Board.

- (a) by omitting the words "the same and all accumulations of interest thereon" and substituting therefor the words "them and all interest accumulated thereon before the commencement of the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1953*"; and
- (b) by omitting the words "the same" (second occurring) and substituting therefor the words "the securities, moneys, investments, and interest so held".

**3** After section three of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

"3A. The Board may use, for the purposes of the *Fruit Board Act 1934*, the interest to accrue due on and after the commencement of the *Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1953* on the securities and moneys vested in it by section two and all investments representing those securities and moneys."

Use by Fruit Board of accumulated interest.

## TOWNS.

### No. 27 of 1953.

#### AN ACT to amend the *Towns Act 1934*.

[23 October, 1953.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Towns Act 1953*.

Short title and citation.

(2) The *Towns Act 1934*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1), after the word "shall" (first occurring), the words "except as provided by section nine A,".

Formation of streets to be under the control of the council.
