AN ACT to amend the Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945. [15 May 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fruitgrowers' Defence Short title and Fund Act 1975.
- (2) The Fruitgrowers' Defence Fund Act 1945, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Purposes for which securities and moneys may be applied.

2 Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting all the words following the words "for the purpose of" and substituting therefor the words "defraying such expenditure relating to and in the interest of the fruit industry in this State as the Board deems fit".
