



FRUITGROWING INDUSTRY RECONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT

ANALYSIS

1. Short title, citation, and commencement.

AN ACT to amend the Fruitgrowing Industry Reconstruction Agreement Act 1972.

[21 November 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Fruitgrowing Industry Reconstruction Agreement Act 1974*. Short title,
citation, and
commencement.

(2) The *Fruitgrowing Industry Reconstruction Agreement Act 1972*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act is deemed to have commenced when the Principal Act commenced.

2 After section 14 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

“ 15 A contract made in pursuance of or for the purposes of any provision of this Act to which a member of either House of Parliament is a party is not a contract or agreement with the Government of the State within the meaning of section 33 of the *Constitution Act 1934*.”.
