AN ACT to amend the Friendly Societies Act 1888. [11 November 1966.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies Short title $Ac\overline{t}$ 1966.
- (2) The *Friendly Societies Act* 1888, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by Rules. adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(2) Paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of this section does not apply to an amendment of a rule of a society or branch. being a society or branch registered or approved as is referred to in section five B, if that amendment is approved under or for the purposes of such a law as is referred to in that section.".
