

## FRIENDLY SOCIETIES.

### No. 39 of 1966.

AN ACT to amend the *Friendly Societies Act 1888*.

[11 November 1966.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Friendly Societies Act 1966*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Friendly Societies Act 1888*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by Rules. adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(2) Paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of this section does not apply to an amendment of a rule of a society or branch, being a society or branch registered or approved as is referred to in section five B, if that amendment is approved under or for the purposes of such a law as is referred to in that section.”.

## LONG SERVICE LEAVE (No. 2).

### No. 40 of 1966.

AN ACT to modify the effect of section three of the *Long Service Leave Act (No. 2) 1963*.

[11 November 1966.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Long Service Leave Act (No. 2) 1966*. Short title, citation, and construction.

(2) The *Long Service Leave Act 1956*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be construed as one with the Principal Act.
