

MARKETING OF PRIMARY PRODUCTS.

11 GEO. VI. No. 20.

AN ACT to amend the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1945*. [22 April, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1947*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1945** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(5) A board established under this Act in respect of eggs may, for the purpose of making arrangements for the marketing of that commodity, with the consent of the Governor, subscribe for and take up shares in any company (whether registered or incorporated in this State or not) having among its objects the marketing, distribution, sale, or disposal of eggs and may pay for such shares, and may make loans or advances to any such company, out of the proceeds of the sale of the commodity or other moneys in the hands of the board.” General powers of boards.

3 Section forty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (5). Regulations.

FLOOD SUFFERERS' RELIEF.

AN ACT to amend the *Flood Sufferers' Relief Act 1929*. [22 April, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Flood Sufferers' Relief Act 1947*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Flood Sufferers' Relief Act 1929**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commence-
ment.

2 This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.

Power to
Board to
write off

3 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act, the Board may write off any amounts owing by any person to the Board in respect of advances under that Act.

PUBLIC SERVICE.

11 GEO. VI. No. 22.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*. [22 April, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act 1947*.

(2) The *Public Service Act 1923**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Regulations.

2 Section seventy-six of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

“(1A) The regulations may authorise the Treasurer to make advances to officers for the purpose of assisting them to purchase motor-vehicles for use in connection with the performance of their official duties, and may prescribe the maximum amount of any such advance, and the terms and conditions upon and subject to which such advances may be made, and may regulate and control generally the making and repayment of such advances.”.

3 Any advance which the Treasurer may be authorised to make by any regulation under subsection (1A) of section seventy-six of the Principal Act may be made out of any moneys for the time being at the disposal of the Treasurer.
