AN ACT to amend the *Friendly Societies (War Service) Act* 1940. [17 June, 1941.]

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by adding at the end of subsection (2) of section six the following proviso:—
“Provided that in the case of a member who has died or has been discharged from His Majesty’s land or air forces without having left Australia, the payment of contributions shall terminate at the expiration of one month from the date of his death or discharge, as the case may be.”.
