AN ACT to amend the Friendly Societies (War Service) Act 1940. [28 October, 1942.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies (War short title. Service) Act 1942.

Friendly Societies (War Service).

A.D. 1942. 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

Amendment of 4 Geo. VI. No. 26. Section 2.

- I. By inserting after the definition of "Member" in section two thereof the following new definition—
 - "'Militia service' means service within Australia during the present war in any of Majesty's land or air forces; and death on militia service includes death from injuries received, or disease contracted, while on militia service:": and

Section 6.

- II. As to section six thereof by inserting the words—
 - (a) "Potentially" before "payable" in the fourth line of subsection (1):
 - (b) "and shall in like manner pay to the credit of the account contributions at the rate of one pound per centum per annum upon the total amount of death claims potentially payable by the society in respect of the death on militia service of members thereof, ascertained as aforesaid." (at the end of subdivision (1)).

Operation of this Act.

3 The provisions contained in section two shall take effect as from the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.
