AN ACT to amend the *Friendly Societies (War Service) Act* 1940. [3 December, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Friendly Societies (War Service) Act* (No. 2) 1940. Short title.

- I. By inserting after the word “received” in the definition of “war service” in section two the words “or disease contracted”:
- II. By inserting after the word “society” in subsection (2) of section six the words “or, in the case of members who enlisted or were called up for war service before the commencement of this Act, from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty, as the case may be,”:

Section 10.

- III. By inserting after subsection (1) of section ten the following new subsection (1A):—
- “(1A) The power conferred by subsection (1) shall extend to authorise the executive committee of a society, with the approval of the Registrar, to increase or vary contributions or levies payable to the society by the members thereof (other than members engaged on war service).”.

3 The amendments effected by section two shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.
