AN ACT to amend the Gaming Act 1935. [27 June, 1940.]

A.D. 1**940.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Gaming Act 1940.

- **2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in section seven thereof—

Amendment of 26 Geo. V. No. 31. Section 7.

- I. "(1)" (at the commencement): and
- II. "(2) The Governor, by order in council, may give permission to any body specified in subsection (3) hereof authorising the disposal, by way of raffle, of any property not exceeding five hundred pounds in value, if the proceeds thereof are to be devoted exclusively to the purposes of such body; and such raffle may be conducted accordingly, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be prescribed. Provided that not more than one permit shall be given in any year."
 - "(3) The bodies to which such permission may be given shall be the Returned Sailors' and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (Tasmanian Branch), and the Red Cross Society of Australia (Tasmanian Section), and the Australian Comforts Fund (Tasmanian Branch)." (at the end).
- This Act shall expire on the thirty-first day of December one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.
