AN ACT to amend the *Guest Houses Registration Act 1937*.  
[1 November, 1938.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Guest Houses Registration Act 1938*. Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By inserting in section seven thereof—

- (a) “(1)” at the commencement: and
- (b) “(2) No person shall conduct, or carry on the business of, a guest house,

unless such house is registered under this Act, or is exempted as hereinafter provided.

Penalty: Twenty pounds, and a daily penalty of two pounds.

“(3) Upon application in the prescribed form by the person conducting a guest house, the Director, if satisfied that such house is so situated that no appreciable number of tourists is likely to resort thereto, may grant as prescribed, exemption of such guest house from the requirement of registration.”:

11. By inserting in section eight thereof—

(a) “(1)” at the commencement: and

(b) “(2) Any such regulations may provide that the Board may classify, as prescribed, the guest houses registered under this Act, and for their registration in accordance with such classification, and for the issue of certificates of registration according to the classes in which such guest houses are placed respectively.”
