- (2) The Railway Advances and Suspense Accounts Act 1923\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Power to therefrom the word "three" and substituting therefor the borrow word "five".
- 3 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended by Limitation to omitting therefrom the word "three" and substituting Stores therefor the word "five".

## AN ACT to amend Section fourteen of the Government Printing Office Act 1949. [1 May, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Government Printing Short title and citation. Office Act 1951.
- (2) The Government Printing Office Act 1949\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section fourteen of the Principal Act is amended by working omitting from subsection (1) the words "twenty thousand" capital and substituting therefor the words "forty-five thousand".
