AN ACT to amend the *Government Printing Office Act 1949*.  
[23 October, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Government Printing Office Act 1953*.

(2) The *Government Printing Office Act 1949*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section fourteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word “forty-five” and substituting therefor the word “seventy-five”.
