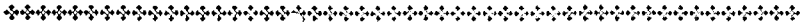

AN ACT to amend the *Glenorchy Sewerage Act* A.D. 1941.
 1940. [13 November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as
 follows:—

Glenorchy Sewerage.

A.D. 1941. **2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after section four the following new section four A—

“**4A** It shall be lawful for the Council, until the works authorised by this Act have been completed, to defray from moneys borrowed by the Council pursuant to this Act all or any portion of the interest accrued and accruing due on moneys borrowed as aforesaid, together with any moneys or any portion thereof which the Council shall be bound to pay in repayment of moneys borrowed as aforesaid, and to treat such interest moneys as part of the capital cost of the said works, and the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, may borrow, on the securities of its revenues in accordance with the provisions of the *Local Government Act* 1906, any sum of money not exceeding the amount of the aforesaid interest and repayment moneys.”

Operation of
amendment.

3 This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.
