AN ACT to amend the *Governor's Salary Act* ^{A.D.} 1945.
1927.

[Reserved, 31st October, 1945; Royal Assent proclaimed,
27th March, 1946.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Governor's Salary Act* 1945. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Governor's Salary Act* 1927*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Governor's Salary.

A.D. 1945. **2**—(1) Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the words “In the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and in each of the eleven succeeding financial years,”.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, 1939.

3 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words “Such cost shall not in any one financial year exceed the sum of four hundred pounds.”.
