AN ACT to further amend the *Glenorchy Water Act 1890.* [16 November, 1942.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Glenorchy Water Act 1942.* Short title and incorporation.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by adding after section 75A thereof the following new section seventy-five B—

“**75B**—(1) It shall be lawful for the trustees to remit or excuse the payment of the whole or any part of any rate, debt, fee, toll, rent, charge, costs, expenses, or sum of money payable to the trustees by any person liable to pay the same, upon the motion of the trustees or upon the application of such person, if it shall appear to the trustees that—

- I. Such person is in indigent circumstances or that the enforcement of payment thereof would create hardship:
- II. The payment would be out of proportion to the benefits received by such person:
- III. The amount cannot be collected: or
- IV. In the interests of the Water District it is advisable to do so—

and the trustees may delegate to the chairman the power to remit and excuse hereby given.

(2) The trustees may require the applicant for any such remission under this section to support his claim by evidence on oath or by statutory declaration in such manner and with such particulars as may be prescribed or the trustees may require.

(3) The trustees shall cause to be kept a remissions book, in which shall be entered particulars of each and every remission granted or payment excused and the reasons for granting the same.
