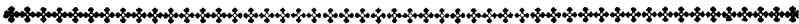

AN ACT to amend the *Homes Act 1935*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Homes Act 1945*.
 (2) The *Homes Act 1935**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 In addition to other amounts which may be borrowed for the purposes of the Principal Act, the Treasurer may borrow any sums not exceeding £750,000 for those purposes.

3 It is hereby declared that the sums authorised to be borrowed by the Acts specified in the second schedule to the Principal Act and by the *Homes Act* 1936*, the *Homes Act* 1939†, the *Homes Act* 1941‡, and by this Act are moneys provided by Parliament for or towards the purpose (*inter alia*) of the acquisition of land for the purposes of Part III. of the Principal Act.
