## AN ACT to amend the Homes Act 1935. [29 March, 1946.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Homes Act 1946. Short title
(2) The Homes Act 1935\*, as subsequently amended, is in and citation. this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Limitation of operation of section 3 of Act. **2** Section fourteen of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "Board" the words "may erect dwelling-houses or ".

**3** After section fourteen of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

"14A. In addition to any other powers conferred on it by this Act, the Board may engage in and carry on, in such manner as it thinks fit, any business or activity incidental to the erection of dwelling-houses, or generally in relation to housing, and may exercise any other powers necessary or convenient for carrying this Act into effect, or for giving effect to such of the provisions of the Commonwealth and State Housing Agreement, in the schedule to the Commonwealth and State Housing Agreement Act 1945\*, as relate to the duties and functions of the State housing authority under that Agreement.".

**4** Section three of this Act shall remain in force till the thirty-first day of December, 1951, and no longer.
