AN ACT to amend the *Homes Act* 1935. [9 December 1959.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Homes Act 1959.
- (2) The *Homes Act* 1935, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Sale of dwelling houses. 2 Section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (5) the words "a monthly tenant, and shall pay therefor" and substituting therefor the words "a tenant on such terms and conditions as the Director may determine, and at".

Remedies for recovery of instalments. 3 Section thirty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words "three months" and substituting therefor the words "one month".
