1. Short title and citation.

2. Long service leave of public hospital employees.

AN ACT to amend the Hospitals Act 1918. [27 June 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Hospitals Act 1973.

Short title and citation.

(2) The Hospitals Act 1918, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section thirty-four A of the Principal Act is amended by omit- $\frac{\text{Long service}}{\text{leave of public}}$ ting subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following sub- $\frac{\text{borg service}}{\text{employees.}}$ sections:—

"(1) Subject to this section, the *State Employees* (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950 (in this section referred to as ' the State Act ') has effect as if—

- (a) a board;
- (b) the Board of Management of the Queen Victoria Hospital;
- (c) the Board of the Queen Alexandra Hospital; and
- (d) the Committee of Management of the Peacock Convalescent Hospital,

were State authorities within the meaning of that Act and accordingly they shall be deemed to be, and to have been from the commencement of that Act, such State authorities.

"(1A) In this section, a reference to a board shall be deemed to include a reference to a Board or the Committee referred to in paragraph (b), paragraph (c), or paragraph (d), as the case requires, of subsection (1) of this section.".
