AN ACT to amend the Hire-Purchase Act 1959.

[11 December 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Hire-Purchase Act 1975*.

(2) The *Hire-Purchase Act 1959*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

2 Section 6 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after subsection (1) (e) (vi) the following sub-paragraph:—

“(via) any amount included in the total amount payable to cover stamp duty in respect of the agreement (in the agreement to be called ‘stamp duty’);”; and

(b) by omitting from subsection (1) (e) (vii) the words “and (vi)” and substituting the words “(vi), and (via)”.

3 The first Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the words “For vehicle registration, &c. \$” the words “For stamp duty \$”.
