AN ACT to amend the Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1929. [14 July, 1944.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Hydro-Electric* Short title Commission Act 1944.
- (2) The Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1929,* as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section seventy-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (3) thereof.

Commission may supply electrical energy. Transfer of contracts with Launceston City Council to Commission.

3 All contracts and agreements made between the Launceston City Council and any person for or in relation to the supply of electricity, or the sale, purchase, or hiring of any electrical appliances, stores, or equipment, shall, on and after the first day of July, 1944, be deemed to have been made between the Commission and that person, and may be enforced by and against the Commission as if the Commission had been named therein, or were a party thereto, instead of the Council.
